JUST BECAUSE IT LOOKS GOOD "CHANGE IT" ANYWAY

"Saving money by not changing the oil filter simply because 'it looks all right' is a poor form of economy."

This is a quote from the article, "Keep It Clean," in the May, 1971 issue of FAA AVIATION NEWS.

As the article says, "The silent watchdog of the engine lubrication system is the oil filter...."

Remember -- the oil filter replaces the oil screen. Always remove the protective perforated cover from the used filter to closely inspect the contaminates that may be trapped in the pleats of the filter medium.

It is common to see small particles of metal in a new or freshly overhauled engine during the break-in period, so do not be alarmed. But regular inspection of the oil filter at oil change periods will assure that the engine is seating in properly during the critical period.

Regular oil filter replacement periods are good economy.
